Michael Reed the record holder 12 hrs. 13 mins, 30 secs must be favourite for todays race. Peter Larrard, a much improved swimmer, pushed Michael hard on a 21 mile swim in July and could push him again today. The other five swimmers are all well known distance swimmers and could do well.

Dilys Beynon is the record holder for the 21 mile Windermere swim and we expect a ladies record from her, Margaret and Suzanne are both very determined long distance swimmers and have completed some tough swims.
